Uranoscodon superciliosus

Northern South America

tropical rainforest, diurnal

Size

up to 50 cm

Life Expectancy

over 7 years

Reproduction

lays up to 12 soft-shelled eggs. Incubation period at 26°C over 100 days.

Temperature

temperature between 25-28°C, local heat spots up to 30°C. Night setback to 20-23°C. A good ventilation is required.

Humidity

80-100%

Lighting

Daylight fluorescent tubes, if necessary UV tubes (see Fluorescent Lighting). For sufficient UV radiation we recommend UV Lamps or the Arcadia D3 Compact. Incandescent Lighting for the creation of local heat spots.

Substrate

loose, absorptive substrate (see cage substrate).

Cage Furniture

Various hiding places, and a large water container with water fall (possibly even an aquaterrarium) make up the basic configuration of the terrarium. Many climbing facilities are a must, if necessary a nature- or structure-background. Planting is required e.g. *Ficus benjamina*, *F. pumila*, *Scindapsus* etc.

food

Insects (e.g. crickets, house crickets, grasshoppers, cockroaches, super mealworms, wax moths, etc.) also products from the Zoo Med Can o' Series. Regular additions of minerals and vitamins are necessary.
