

Many-colored Bush Anole

Polychrus marmoratus

Cites status

not protected

Habitat

South America

lowland-rainforest, diurnal

Size

over 30 cm

Reproduction

lays more than 10 soft-shelled eggs. Incubation period at 27-30°C about 60-70 days.

Temperature

temperature between 26-28°C, local heat spots up to 33°C. Night setback to 20-23°C. A good ventilation is required.

Humidity

80-100%

Lighting

Daylight fluorescent tubes, if necessary UV tubes (see Fluorescent Lighting). For sufficient UV radiation we recommend UV Lamps or the Arcadia D3 Compact. Incandescent Lighting for the creation of local heat spots.

Substrate

loose, absorptive substrate (see cage substrate).

Cage Furniture

climbing facilities, additionally a nature or rock-background is recommended. Planting is required (*Ficus benjamina*, *F. pumila*, *Scindapsus* etc.). Various hiding places and a large water container with waterfall (possibly even an aquaterrarium) complete the configuration of the terrarium.

food

Insects (e.g. crickets, house crickets, grasshoppers, cockroaches, super mealworms, wax moths, etc.) also products from the Zoo Med Can o' Series. Regular additions of minerals and vitamins are necessary.
