

Blue-Lipped Tree Lizard

Reproduction

lays 2-4 eggs

Temperature

air temperature between 26-28°C, local heat spots up to 30°C. Night setback to 20-23°C.

Humidity

80-100%

Lighting

Daylight fluorescent tubes, if necessary UV tubes (see Fluorescent Lighting). For sufficient UV radiation we recommend UV Lamps or the Arcadia D3 Compact. Incandescent Lighting for the creation of local heat spots.

Substrate

loose, absorptive substrate (see cage substrate).

Cage Furniture

Various hiding places, and a large water container with water fall (possibly even an aquaterrarium) make up the basic configuration of the terrarium. Many climbing facilities, if necessary a nature- or structure-background. Planting is required e.g. Ficus benjamina, F. pumila Scindapsus etc.

food

Insects (e.g. crickets, house crickets, grasshoppers, cockroaches, super mealworms, wax moths, etc.) also products from the Zoo Med Can o' Series. Regular additions of minerals and vitamins are necessary.
