Leiocephalus personatus

Haiti

from sandy beaches to lightly wooded areas

Size

over 20 cm

Life Expectancy

over 10 years

Reproduction

lays about 6 eggs. Incubation period at 28°C about 60-70 days.

Temperature

Ground temperature between 26-28°C, local heat spots up to 40°C.

Humidity

60-70%

Lighting

Daylight fluorescent tubes, if necessary UV tubes (see Fluorescent Lighting). For sufficient UV radiation we recommend UV Lamps or the Arcadia D3 Compact. Incandescent Lighting for the creation of local heat spots. If necessary the use of HQI lamps or T5 fluorescent tubes is recommended.

Substrate

loamy earth with rock structures or Sand or grit. Also Reptile Cannabis Bedding.

Cage Furniture

hiding places, stones and roots also climbing facilities and a flat water bowl. Cage substrate should always be slightly wet in one spot.

food

Insects (e.g. crickets, house crickets, grasshoppers, cockroaches, super mealworms, wax moths, etc.) also products from the Zoo Med Can o' Series. Regular additions of minerals and vitamins are necessary.

Comments

Species can be tended well together in small groups (e.g. 1 male and 2-4 females).
