

## Lined Gecko

Gekko vittatus

### Cites status

not protected

### Habitat

Indo-Australian archipelago, Java (?), Timor to New Guinea and Oceania

rainforests, civilisation follower, crepuscular and nocturnal

### Size

up to 25 cm

### Life Expectancy

over 10 years

### Reproduction

several clutches per year, in general 2 hard-shelled eggs each. Incubation period at 28-30°C between 90-160 days.

### Temperature

air temperature between 26-28°C, local heat spots up to 35°C. Night setback to 20-23°C.

### Humidity

70-95%

### Lighting

Daylight fluorescent tubes, e.g. Natural Sunlight or Zoo Med ReptiSun 2.0

### Substrate

loose, absorptive substrate (see cage substrate).

### Cage Furniture

climbing facilities, a background is recommended. Planting is possible (Ficus benjamina, F. pumila, Scindapsus etc.). Various hiding places and a large water tank with waterfall or similar (possibly even an aqua-terrarium) make up the basic configuration of the terrarium.

### food

Insects (e.g. crickets, house crickets, grasshoppers, cockroaches, super mealworms, wax moths, etc.) also products from the Zoo Med Can o' Series. Regular additions of minerals and vitamins are necessary.

### Comments

It is recommended to tend them in pairs. Group tendace should also be possible.
